

How to Setup Access Point Name (APN) on 3Rtablet for TrackM2M Services

If you are using TrackM2M mobility network service / SIM card for a 3Rtablet (any other brand/model of Android tablets will have a similar setup), this document describes how to setup the Access Point Name (APN) which is required for a successful network connection.

Note: This procedure may require that a physical SIM card is installed in the tablet.

Starting from the Home screen (tap Home button/icon along right-side of 3Rtablet screen to get to Home screen). Swipe upward anywhere in the background of the Home screen to display the list of all apps.

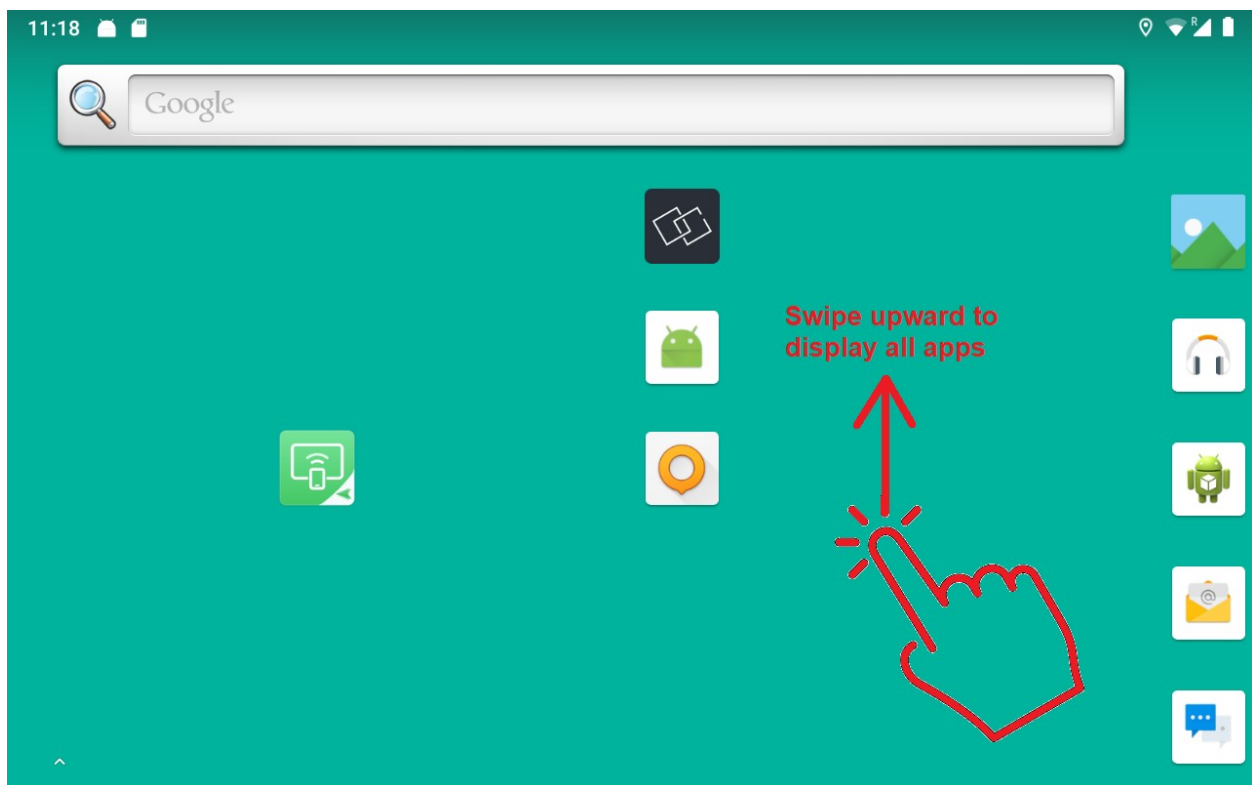


Fig 1: Typical Android Home screen of 3Rtablet.

Look for the **Settings** icon/app and tap to open.

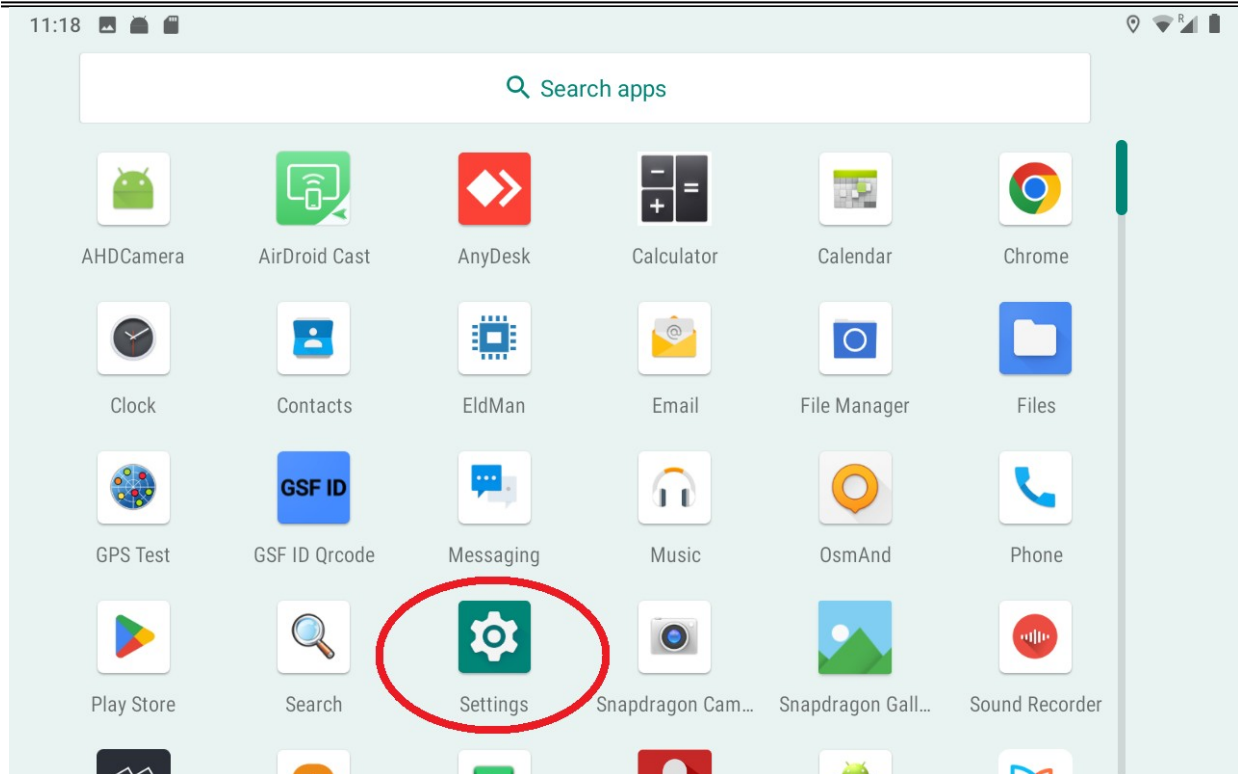


Fig. 2: Display of all apps installed on tablet. Tap the **Settings** icon.

Look for **Network & internet** and tap to open these settings.

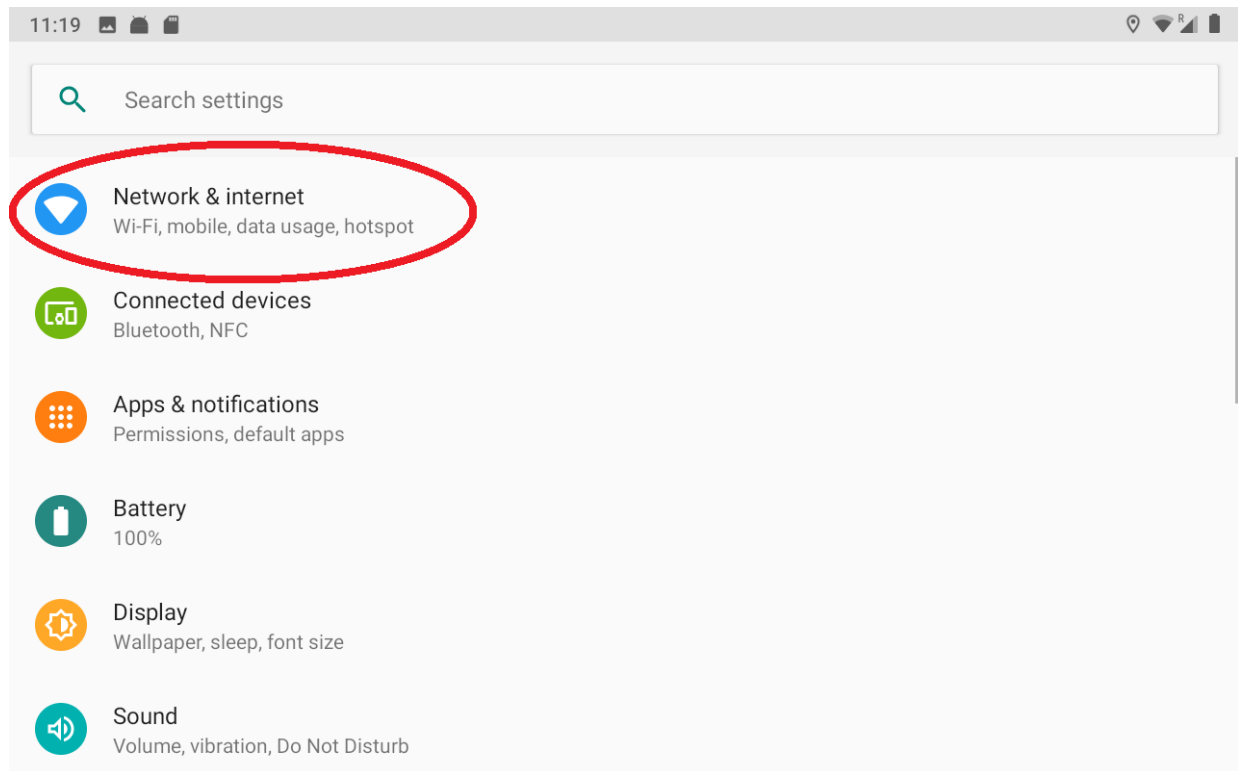


Fig. 3: Open the **Network & internet** settings.

Look for the **Mobile network** settings and tap to open.

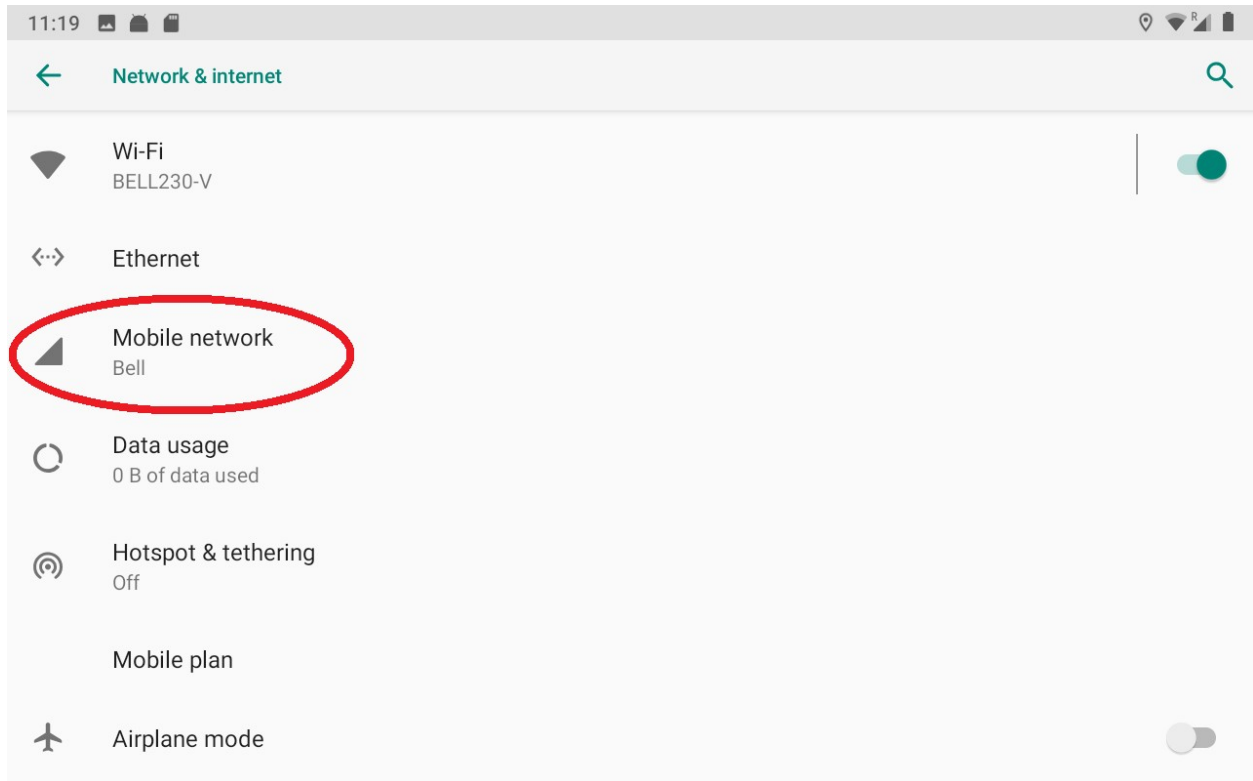


Fig. 4: Open the **Mobile network** settings.

Mobile data and **Roaming** settings should be turned on by default. Check that these settings are enabled.

Tap the **Advanced** drop down to see more settings.

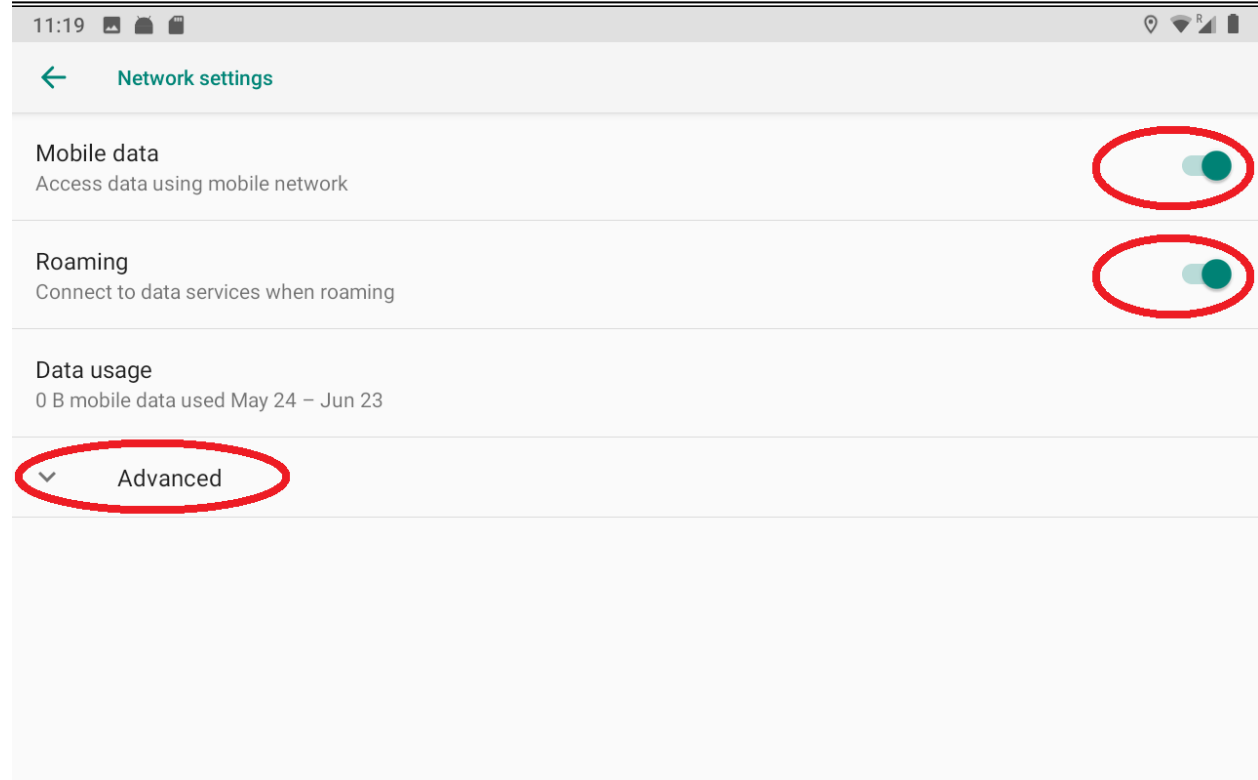


Fig. 5: Check that **Mobile data** and **Roaming** are turned on. Tap **Advanced** to see more settings.

Scroll all the way to the bottom of the settings list to find **Access Point Names**. Tap **Access Point Names** to open the APN list.

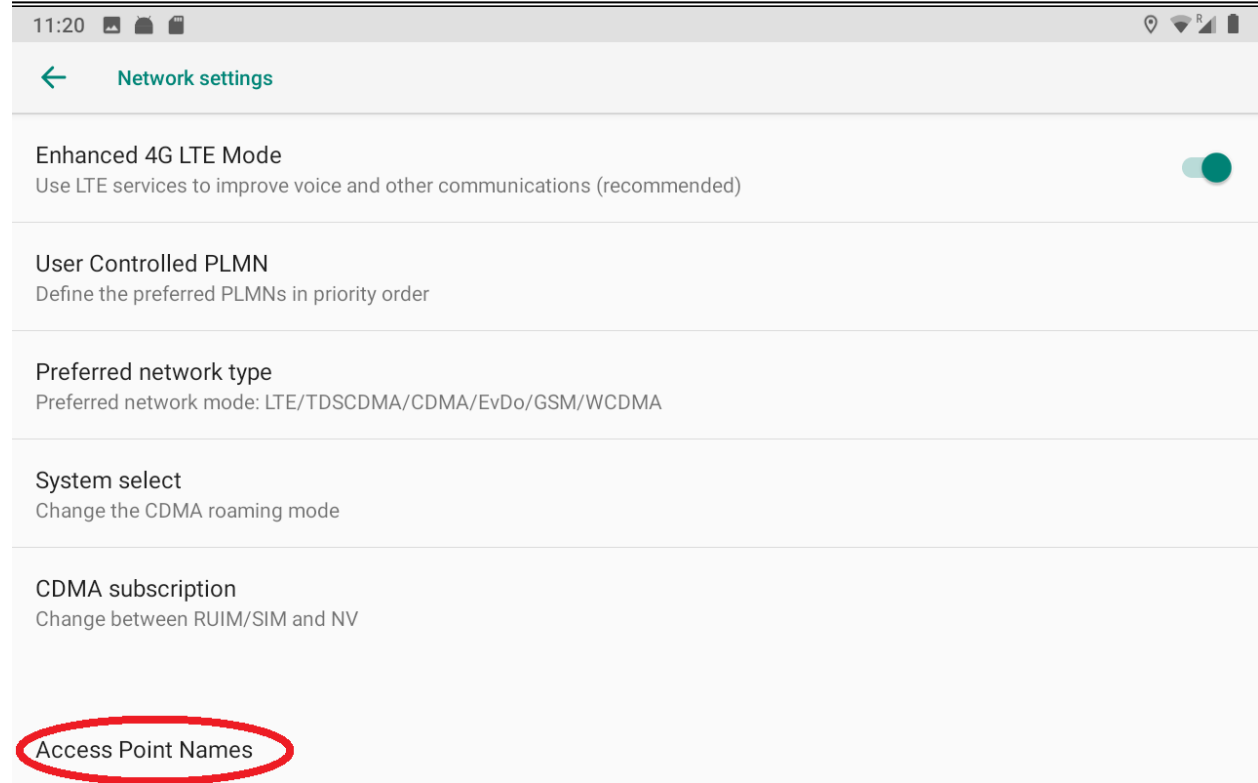


Fig. 6: Tap on **Access Point Names** to open APN list.

Check if there is an APN set to `usdata.fast`. If so, skip to the last step of this document/procedure to ensure this APN is selected.

If there is no APN set to `usdata.fast`, tap the + icon in the top-right to add a new APN.

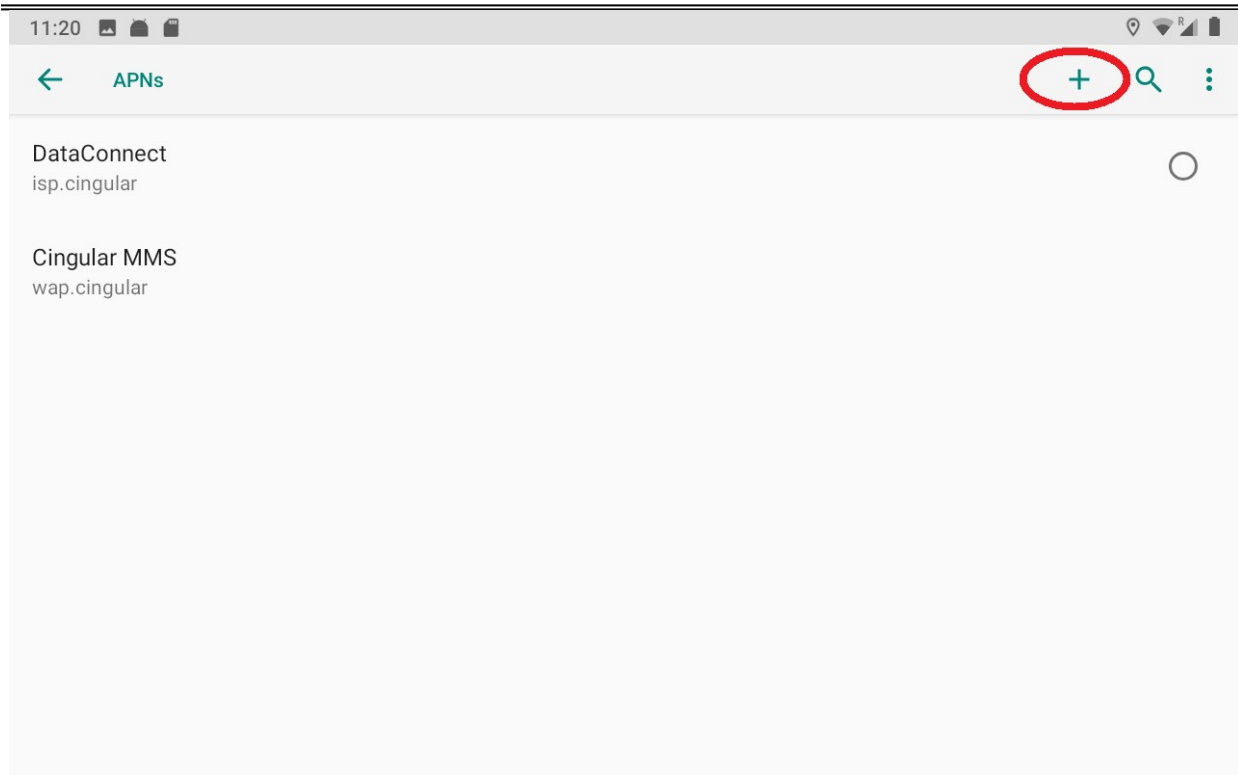


Fig. 7: Check if there is an APN set to usdata . fast; if not, tap + icon to add a new APN.

On the new APN, the Name and APN fields must filled. No other fields are required.

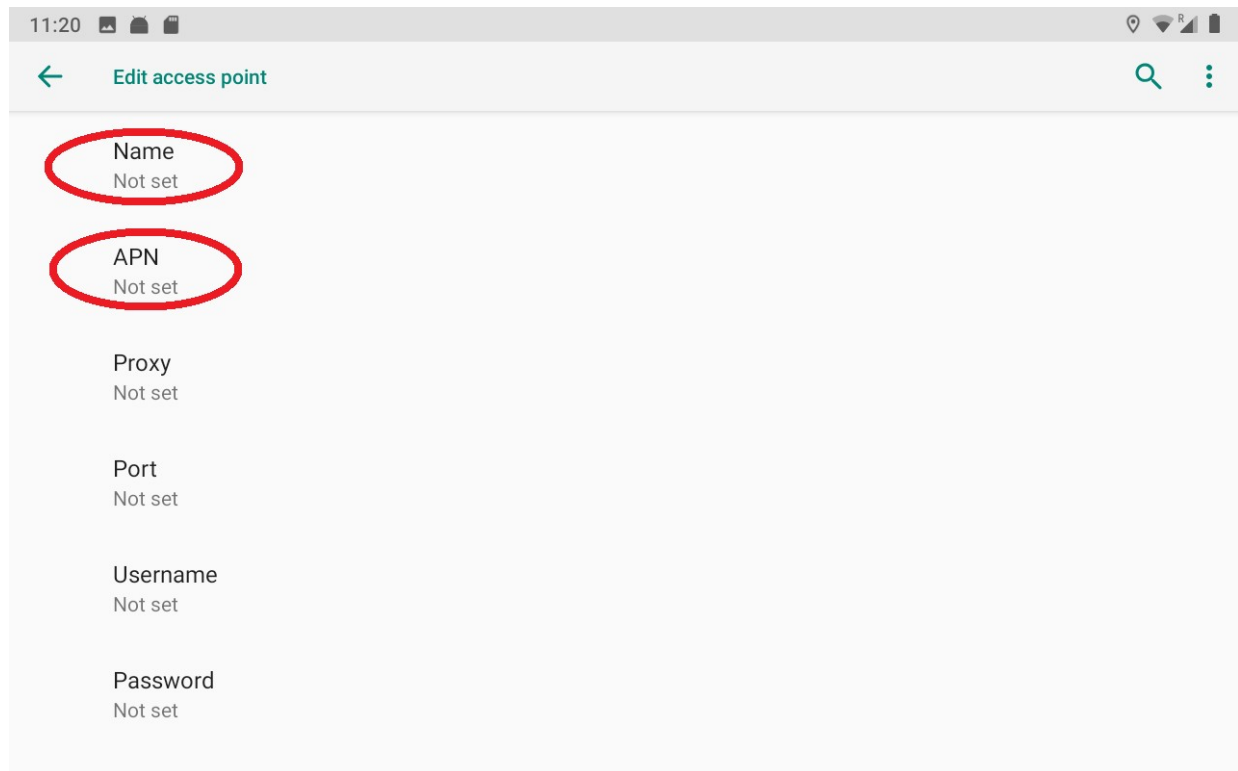


Fig. 8: APN Name and APN fields must be filled.

Fill in `usdata.fast` for each of **Name** and **APN** fields.

Note: The **Name** can be anything, but APN must be exactly the characters `usdata.fast` (all lowercase). It is convenient to set the **Name** the same as the **APN**.

Tap the 3 dot icon in top-right to open the menu.

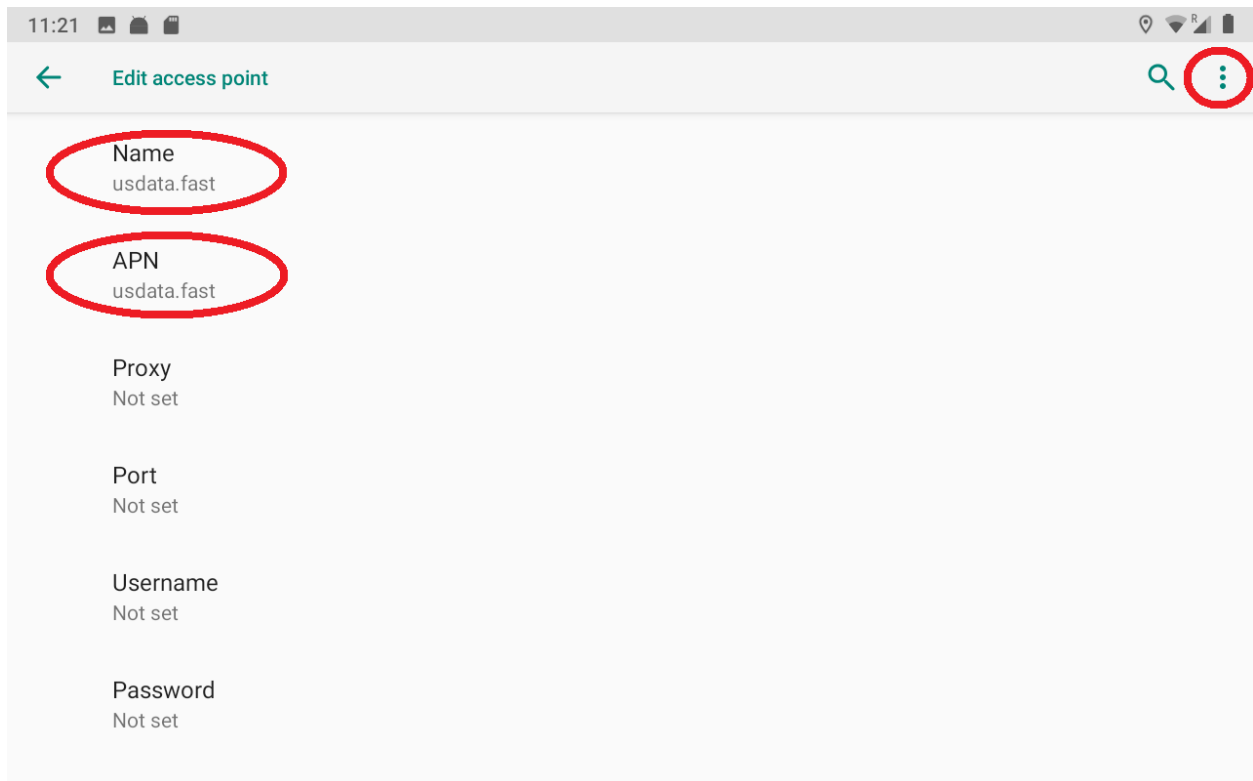


Fig. 9: Fill in **Name** and **APN** with `usdata.fast`. Tap the 3 dot icon in top-right to open menu.

Tap **Save** in the menu. The new APN will be saved and the screen will return to the APN list.

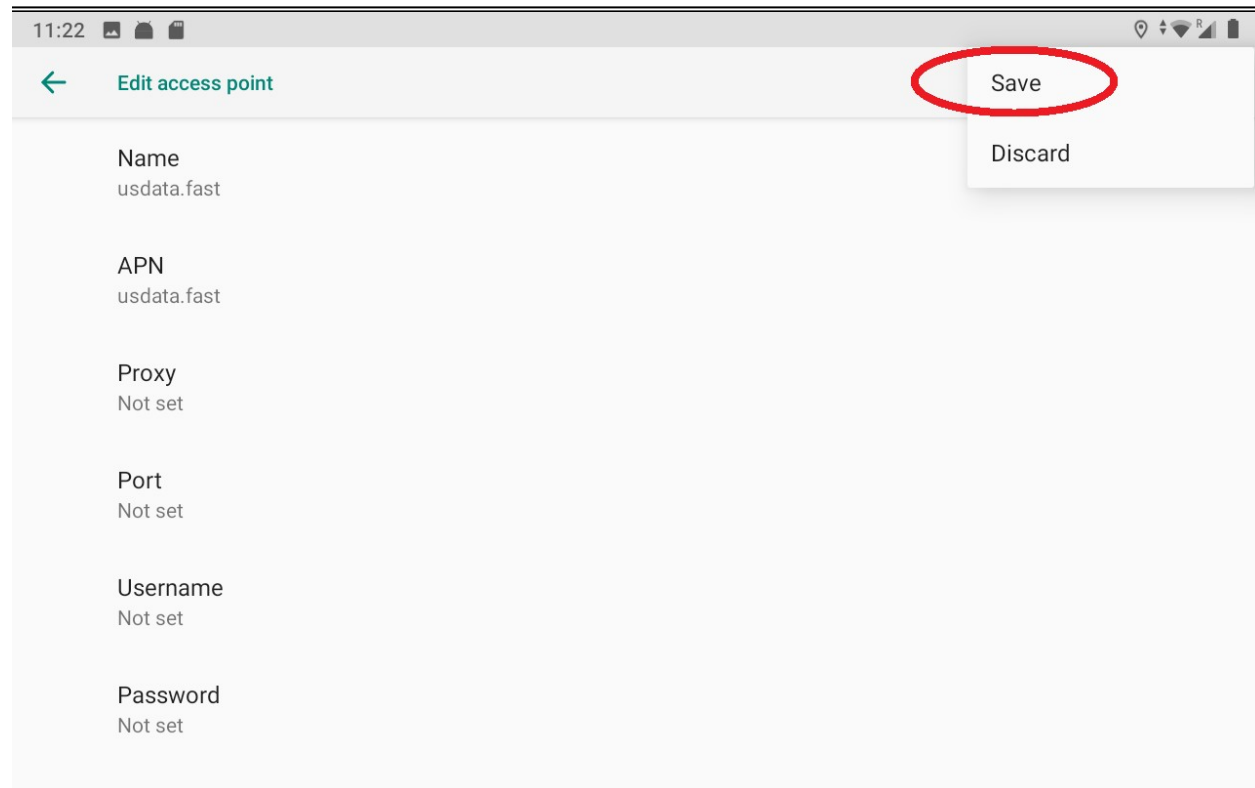


Fig. 10: Tap **Save** in menu to save new APN and return to APN list.

The new APN will now be displayed in the APN list. However, the new APN will need to be selected along the right-side.

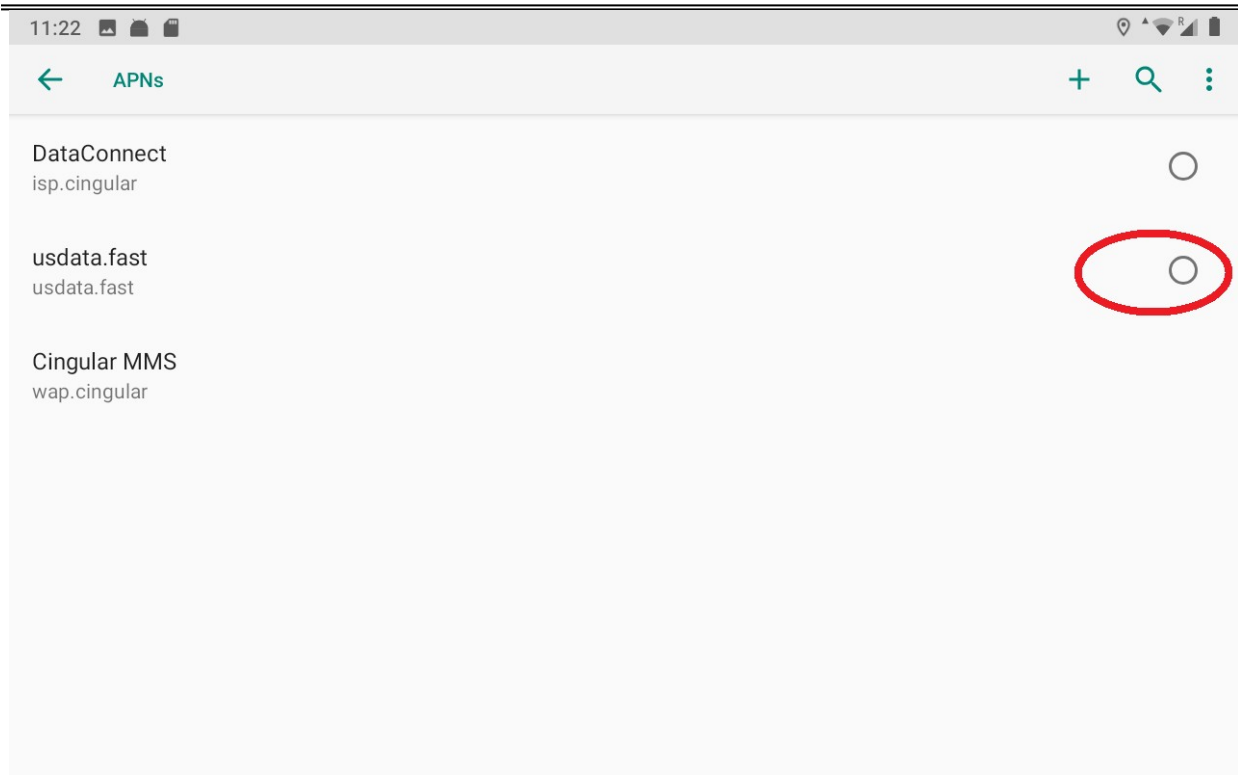


Fig. 11: The new APN called usdata . fast needs to be selected.

Tap the circle selector to the right of the new usdata . fast APN to select it.

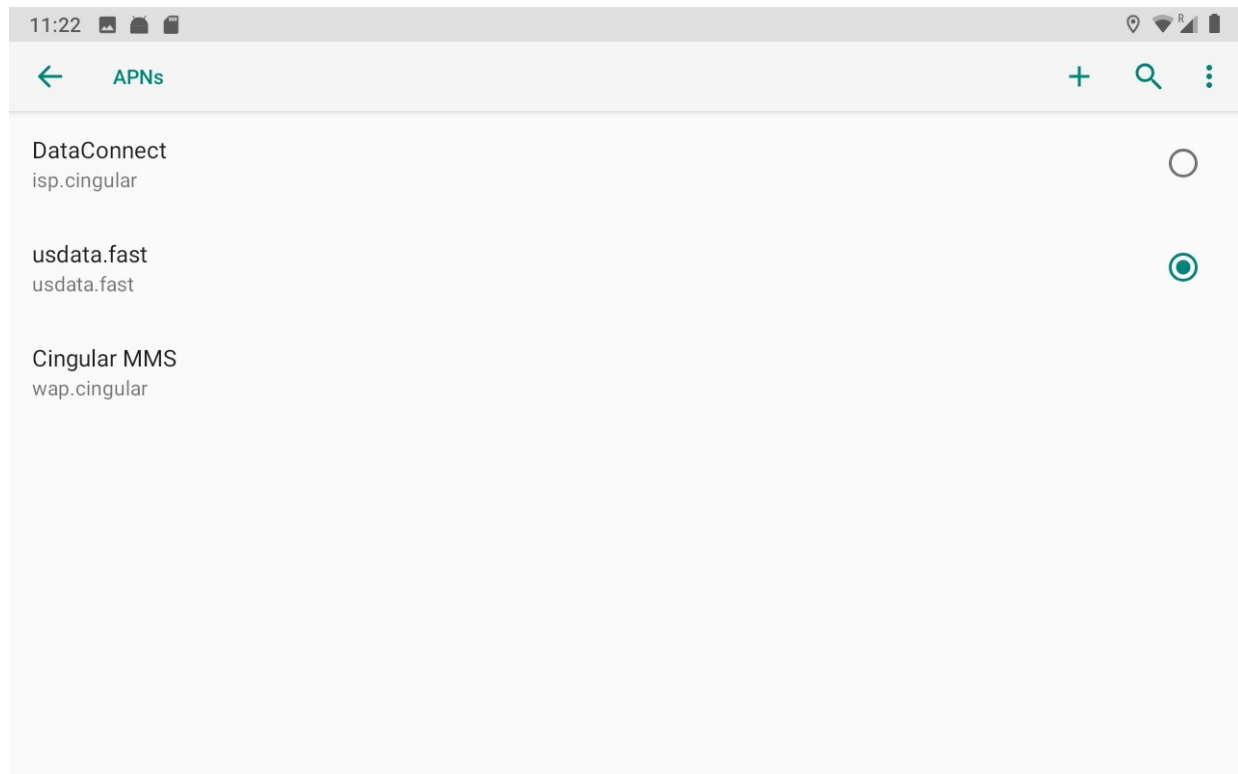


Fig. 12: The usdata . fast APN is now configured.
